Luggage Point Waste Water Treatment Plant Site Visit

Nestled between the Brisbane International Airport and the Brisbane River, the Luggage Point Waste Water Treatment Plant is an advanced water treatment plant which produces up to 70 ML of purified recycled water per day for use in local industry.

Comprised of pre-treatment, microfiltration, reverse osmosis and advanced oxidation processes, the Luggage Point plant is one of three advanced water treatment plants commissioned for the Western Corridor Recycled Water Project for the South East Queensland Water Grid in 2007.

The technical tour will focus on the membrane technology employed at the site. The tour will depart from the Hilton at 10 am on Thursday July 10th, returning after 12 pm.

Requirements:

- Full-length clothing (long sleeved shirts/pants)
- Safety boots or fully-enclosed shoes
